3. Submit the article with quality reflected in precise and clear writing, free of spelling or typing errors, and corresponding to relevant research results or reflection articles.
4. Not submit the article provided to the Latin American Journal of Ethnomathematics, either in whole or in part, to other publications while the evaluation process is ongoing.

5. Strictly follow the GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS defined by the Latin American Journal of Ethnomathematics for manuscript submission (no text will proceed to evaluation if it does not comply with these guidelines).
6. Respect intellectual property and give proper credit to the work of other authors or entities by indicating the full source of all third-party information.
7. Provide complete and accurate information for all references included in the work. Citations in the text must match the references listed at the end of the article.
8. Cite their own previously published work when relevant, but avoid excessive self-citation to prevent self-plagiarism.
9. Avoid recycling previous work.
10. Avoid plagiarism, falsification, misrepresentation, or omission of significant material.
11. Respond promptly to questions or requests for clarification from the editor or reviewers regarding authorship authenticity or sources of information.
12. Carefully consider reviewers' comments and revision requests, and respond clearly, precisely, and with justification in case of disagreement, through a letter sent via email to the Editor-in-Chief ([revista.etnomatematica@gmail.com](mailto:revista.etnomatematica@gmail.com)).

13. Provide the requested author and article information after evaluation and/or final approval, using the CV FORMAT provided, for inclusion in the Publindex platform.
14. Remain available via email for both the Editor-in-Chief ([revista.etnomatematica@gmail.com](mailto:revista.etnomatematica@gmail.com)) and the editorial assistant ([revista@etnomatematica.org](mailto:revista@etnomatematica.org)) to clarify any issues during the editing process within a maximum of 72 hours (three days).

#### **REVIEWERS COMMIT TO:**

1. Respect the confidentiality policy of the journal, maintaining double-blind review and not disclosing or distributing submitted materials.
2. Accept only works aligned with their academic background and areas of expertise that contribute to knowledge.
3. Review submissions responsibly, objectively, impartially, and promptly.
4. Provide clearly explained evaluations according to the journal's Evaluation Format.
5. Deliver a verdict within a maximum of 20 calendar days.
6. Use respectful language and avoid offensive expressions when evaluating authors' work.

7. Be available to the director and editorial assistant when clarification is required.

#### **THE DIRECTOR AND EDITORIAL BOARD COMMIT TO:**

1. Safeguard the journal's reputation by publishing only original, academically and scientifically relevant, high-quality material.
2. Publish issues continuously throughout the year once the preparation process is completed.
3. Classify submissions based on whether they require peer review and inform authors accordingly.
4. Conduct a preliminary review to verify compliance with submission guidelines.
5. Accept or reject submissions based solely on anonymous peer review and editorial evaluation; if reviews conflict, a third reviewer will be appointed.
6. Not alter reviewers' reports; these must be communicated as received, although editors may provide additional perspectives if needed.
7. Ensure that new editors do not overturn publication decisions approved by previous editorial boards.
8. Promote adherence to the journal's Code of Ethics to identify research and publication misconduct.

9. Encourage collaboration among authors and reviewers to assess originality and detect plagiarism or redundancy.
10. Request active contributions from editorial board members when necessary.
11. Maintain editorial independence from university authorities.
12. Ensure ongoing training provided by the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MinCiencias) for all staff.
13. Maintain mutual confidentiality with authors and reviewers.
14. Allow authors the right to appeal editorial decisions through formal letters.
15. Keep authors informed throughout the submission and decision process.
16. Ensure a transparent editing and publication process with full respect for authors.
17. Be available to authors and reviewers to clarify doubts during evaluation and editing.
18. Apply anti-plagiarism systems to detect data falsification or plagiarism.
